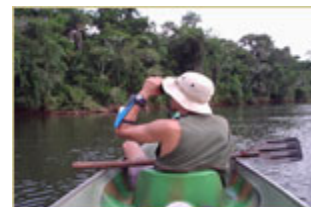
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1. Program

-Day 1: (1 N 4-star hotel)
 Morning arrival at Buenos Aires. Transfer to your hotel.
 Option: City tour and Tango show

-Day 2 (1 N Jungle Lodge) (Breakfast, Dinner)
 Early morning, flight to Iguazú, in the province of Misiones. Our staff will pick you up at the airport and drive you to the Jungle Lodge. The Lodge is perfectly located outside of Puerto Iguazu near the 3 borders pass". Free afternoon. The semicircular Iguazú waterfall is some 80 mts high and 2,700 mts D and is situated on a basaltic line spanning the border between Argentina and Brazil. Formed by many cascades producing vast sprays of water, it is one of the most spectacular waterfalls in the world. The surrounding subtropical rainforest has over 2,000 species of vascular plants and homes tapirs, giant anteaters, howler monkeys, ocelots, jaguars and caymans.



-Days 3 (1 N Jungle Lodge) (B, Dinner)
 After breakfast, a full day enjoying the excursions "Great Adventure" and "Ecological Tour" at the waterfalls

(Argentinian side).

The great adventure is to let the Iguazú waterfalls get under your skin, bewitching your very soul. This ride is a perfect mingle of water and jungle, it starts taking you deep into the Garganta del Diablo canyon (The Devil's Throat Canyon) in a motorboat steered by experts in the area, allowing you to experience the majestic falls. Then we sail 9 km down the Iguazú river, the way the Spanish Conquerors followed, to end up in Macuco Harbor. Now this is the very beginning of an unforgettable adventure: we will drive you 12 Km into the jungle, the "Selva Misionera" of the Iguazú National Park. 4WD vehicles are adequate for these jungle roads. After an unbelievable 1 hour tour, the great adventure ends at the Viejo Hotel (Old Hotel) parking lot, where the journey began.

-Day 4: (1 N Jungle Lodge) (B, Dinner)

Visit of the waterfalls of the Brazilian side.

-Day 5: (1 N Yacutinga) (B, Lunch, Dinner)

Free morning. At approximately 2 pm, you will catch the Transfer to Puesto de Tigre, to reach Yacutinga Lodge in the midst of the jungle. That will be a 45 Km ride through the park on 4WDs. Your guide will show you the different flora and fauna species. Then we will sail for about 45' on the calm Iguazú Superior River, up to the Yacutinga post.



The premises of the lodge, built with local materials such as stone and large logs from fallen trees, harmonize perfectly with the natural environment. Only 4 hectares out of the 570-hectare area of the natural reserve have been used to set up the complex. You will be astonished at the amazing plant strata climbing up to the tree tops and the profuse vines of different types and sizes, creating an entwined frame for uncountable epiphytes.

The free space between the different vegetation layers homes colorful birds like toucans, black fronted piping guans, trogons and woodpeckers. With wildlife at full glow, extravagant colors, shades and dimensions, immensely rich flora and fauna of species... the jungle is utterly impossible to describe. Accommodation at the lodge, reception, Dinner.



Day 6: (1 N Yacutinga) (Full Board)

During the morning we will go on sailing on Riacho San Francisco: animal-lovers, get your cameras ready! A great opportunity to watch and photograph fauna. Duration: 3hs. Return to the lodge. Lunch.

You will have the whole afternoon free to enjoy all the activities the lodge offers (swimming-pool, sightseeing, tours around the forest...)

Return to the lodge. Dinner.

After dinner, a wonderful night excursion: "La Selva de Noche" (The Jungle at Night)

-Day 7 (1 N 4-star hotel) (B, Brunch, D)

During the morning, you can rest or enjoy the activities of Yacutinga Lodge.

In the afternoon, transfer to the local airport and flight to Buenos Aires. Our staff will drive you to the hotel. Free evening.

-Day 8 (B)

Transfer to airport. End of services.

OPTION: FOLLOWING THE TRACKS OF THE JAGUAR

The American Jaguar, also known as Yaguareté (Leo Onca) is the bigger predator of the Jungle Paranaense; his presence means that the area still possesses a high degree of conservation. It was hunted for its fur or simply out of fear for many years until the Government declared the site a "Protected Natural Monument" banning yaguareté (jaguar) hunting. Today the Jaguar lives in the Parks and Reservations that cover 15,4 % of the provincial surface. Zekeseven proposes to visit and cross the home areas of the Jaguar, following its tracks in the jungle guided by an old hunter who is today a naturalist.



- Day 7

Transfer from Puerto Iguazú. Visit to the Refuge Timbó Gigante, an protected gigantic tree. Lunch at "Stay of the High Parana". We visit a Colonist who has a very particular way of preserving captured Yaguareté. Lodging in a Refuge near the 92.000-hectares Provincial Park Urugua-I.

- Day 8

After breakfast, we enter the Jungle with the help of Albino Mackowiak, a former Yaguareté hunter. We search for and follow the tracks of the magnificent feline. Return to the Refuge and dinner.

- Day 9

Breakfast. Trekking in the Provincial Park Urugua-I accompanied by Park Guards. Lunch, check out and transfer to Posadas.

Lodging at hotel or estancia.

- Day 10

Transfer to the airport and flight to Buenos Aires. Our staff will drive you to the hotel. Free evening.

- Day 11

Transfer to airport. End of services.

-Information:

Level

This adventure does not require any special physical level. Enjoying outdoor sports is what matters.

Gears

We suggest taking adequate clothing: light T-shirts... 2 pairs of footwear: 1 light, 1 medium trekking, 1 back pack (40-45 l). All special gears for outdoors activities are provided.

Climate

It is usually cool in Buenos Aires from March to November (15°C Average). It may also be cold during July and August. The climate can be a little bit dry, but the countryside receives humidity from storms coming from the ocean.

The Iguazú National Park (Northeast) is a tropical zone: wet, with temperatures rising up to 30°C (18° to 25°C average). With large amounts of rain, warm temperatures and thick vegetation acting as windscreen, it has extremely high levels of humidity.

Natural reserve Yacutinga

The astonishing presence of several plant strata overlaying from the ground to the high tree tops; profuse vines of all types and sizes, creating an intricate and entwined frame for numerous epiphytes that hang from all that can serve as support.

The free space between the different vegetation layers is home to colorful birds like toucans, black fronted piping guans, trogons and woodpeckers.

Life in one of its richest expressions within a frame full of species, shades, dimensions and colors, makes it almost impossible to describe.

This combination of abundant biodiversity is the result of a natural chaos, and which can only be understood by someone who has seen and admired something similar and unforgettable.

The subtropical Forest impresses as a whole entity, it is admirable in its parts and its details arouse curiosity.

The majestic silence that at times dominates the jungle allows our hearing to enjoy an terrific sensation and, at the same time, warns us of a coming on change of weather.

The songs of birds, the buzzing of insects and the rustle of the breeze moving the tress conspire in disrupting this silent and oppressive calmness.

While staying at the Natural Reserve we reunite with our primitive escence to discover our senses, which have nearly been atrophied by urban life.

It is greatly important for the visitor to understand that although it is possible to observe larger animals, this is not usual. Yacutinga Wildlife Reserve offers protection to several endangered species, such as the South American Jaguar, Tapir, Ocelot and some severely threatened bird species.

Time

Currency

The local currency is the peso. One euro is about 4 pesos and one Usd is about 3 pesos. It is not necessary to travel with a lot of cash (pesos or dollars). Visa, MasterCard or American express are useful all the time.

Customs

To enter the country, only a passport is needed.

Health

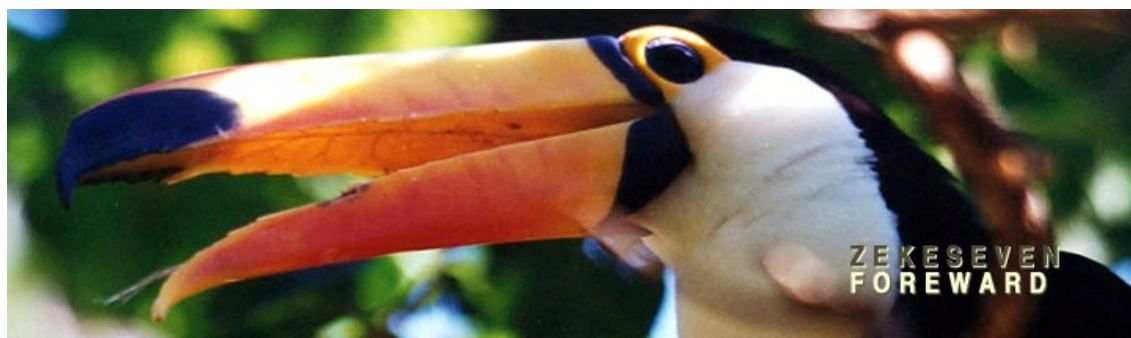
Nothing is compulsory concerning vaccination. Being vaccinate against Hepatitis B is recommended. We advise NOT drinking tap water.

Food

Argentina is well known for its wines mainlt produced in the province of Mendoza, near the Andes and ... for its beef!: ask for a « bife de chorizo » or « lomo ». While in Patagonia try the lamb barbecue, and a trout from the lakes and a Pacific salmon!

If you are a vegetarian, don't worry, Argentina is a great fruit and vegetable producer, so you will find variety and quality at very low prices.

Prices

Prices are in Euros or US Dollars per pax. When booking, a deposit of 30% of the contract is required (100% if booking less than 1 month before departure date). Prices can be modified without advanced notice. The entire value of international and domestic air fares will be paid when booking.

Cancellations

Up to 30 days before the trip, all the money will be refunded, except administrative costs (100 US\$). As from 29 to 15 days before departure date: 60% of the contract value will be refunded. As from 14 to 7 days: 30%, and if cancelled less than 7 days before the trip no refunds will be granted.

Special terms for domestic and international flights: refund according to the cancellation policy of each airline company.

Booking

Bookings must be sent by fax or e-mail to our Buenos Aires center. Each booking will be considered confirmed against a payment of 30% of the contract . Customers will then receive a fax or e-mail confirming their booking.

Taxes

All the taxes are included in the programs and the services fitting the contract, except taxes at the Buenos Aires Ezeiza Airport (nearly 18 US\$ per pax.) and taxes of some domestic airports inside Argentina.

Modifications

Each confirmed booking modification will depend on the lodging availabilities and on the airline cancellation system.
